NEED TO KNOW

Player information

All players must read this information. If you are a parent or guardian, please ensure your child understands the following points.

- Coaches recommend that developing young players attend more than one lesson a week. Players must be willing to put effort into improving.
- Players must be appropriately dressed for the weather conditions. The dome can get very cold in winter and any child that is inappropriately dressed will be asked to stay in the Clubhouse. Inappropriate clothing for lessons will result in children not being able to take part. **Jeans, sandals and school shoes are not allowed.**
- Any player who shows inappropriate behavior in a lesson will be asked to leave and wait in the Clubhouse. During match play, players will receive code violations for inappropriate behavior. Three code violations in a term will result in disqualification for the remainder of that term and may not be allowed back. This will also include any tournaments they may participate in over the holidays.
- **Parents should accompany players to and from courtside.** Coaches are only responsible for players for the duration of the session. Players are not encouraged to wait in the car park to be collected.
- **Players must always bring a drink to lessons.**
- **All players should arrive on time for lessons.** Arriving late to any session reduces time on court and does not allow for sufficient warm-up time, which can result in injury. If you are not able to arrive on time, please let your coach know.
- Siblings not participating in a session must remain seated at the courtside or wait in the Clubhouse with a parent. Coaches reserve the right to ask parents to withdraw sibling who may be causing disruption to the lesson in progress.
- The Coach reserves the right to ask any child or parent to leave if their behavior is not in line with expectations.

Ts & Cs and course info

- A course booking form must be completed and handed to a member of the coaching staff every term. This ensures all player information is up to date. This will only be used by the Club.
- **Payment for the term must be made within the first two weeks of term starting. The committee reserves the right to remove any player from a course that they have not paid for in full.**
- Cancellation Policy – Refunds can only be given if a doctor's letter is received to confirm that the child is unable to participate in the course; refunds will be given for the remainder of the term, not lessons that have already been taken. In exceptional circumstances, at the discretion of the committee, a refund may be permitted for a course that has already started.
